

IOSSO WATER REPELLENT FACT SHEET

*Recommended uses: awnings, canopies, tents, tarps, boat covers, boat seats, carpeting, patio furniture, cushions, umbrellas, spa covers, camping gear, leather, solution dyed acrylics, synthetics, laminated fabrics coated fabrics, and vinyls.

*Protects fabric from water, soils, oils.

*Resists mildew and stains and increases weatherability.

*Will not cause yellowing, or change color, feel or breatheability of the fabric.

*Is not flammable as petroleum based products are. Also, easily ships by either ground or air without any special tags.

*Non-silicon, non-petroleum distillate formula which will not attract dirt.

*Directions for ready to use formula: fabric should be cleaned and thoroughly dried before application. Spray Iosso Water Repellent directly and generously to fabric. Item may also be soaked in the solution. Let dry thoroughly. Keep fabric dry for 24 hours before exposing to water. Items may also be dried in a clothes dryer. For added protection, a second application may be applied within 5 minutes of the first one.

*For large areas – solution may be applied with an applicator sprayer. If spraying – use a pump type sprayer or sprayer with pressure less than 30psi.

*Directions for mixing concentrate formula: to make one gallon, add 26 ounces of concentrate to 102 ounces of water and mix well. To make five gallons of water repellent, add one gallon of concentrate to four gallons of water and mix well.

*One gallon will cover approximately 150 square feet.

*Available in 22 oz water repellent spray bottle, 1 gallon water repellent. 1 gallon water repellent makes 5 gallons. Also available in 5 gallon up to 55 gallon drums, either in ready to use formula or concentrate.
